

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The building will be open at 8 a.m. with judging commencing at 9 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. **Friday set-up is from 6-8 p.m.**
2. Only dogs entered in these events will be allowed in the building.
3. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, provided that the owner has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.
4. Dogs will not be allowed in the building overnight.
5. Prong or Spike collars will not be permitted at this venue.
6. **Judging will proceed without any dog that is not present when called by the Ring Steward. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers should judging times conflict.**
7. All Group judging will begin on completion of Breed judging within each group. Best In Show, Best Puppy In Show, and Reserve Best In Show will follow all Group judging. Reserve Best In Show will immediately follow Best In Show.
8. The Superintendent will be in full charge of the events.
9. The S.S.K.C. reserves the right to restrict the size and location of crates and exercise pens.
10. Judging Schedules and Identifying Cards will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
11. The S.S.K.C. will use all due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of an accident or any misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or spectators.
12. The S.S.K.C. greatly appreciates your co-operation in keeping the show building and grounds clean. Please clean up after your dogs.
13. Canteen facilities will be available.

Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules regarding these events.**

ENTRY INFORMATION

- All entries must be received by the Show Secretary by the closing date and submitted on an official CKC entry form. If more forms are required, please photocopy. Include postal code and telephone number.
- Post-dated cheques will not be accepted, and all "NSF" cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00.
- The S.S.K.C. reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how the error was made or who made it.
- Any overpayment of fees will be considered a contribution to our trophy fund.

ADVERTISING: Full page: \$30.00; ½ page: \$15.00. All copy must be ready for printing and received by the Show Secretary prior to the closing date.

BOOTH SPACE: Weekend: \$40.00 per single space (size 10'x 10'). **One vendor per booth. Must be pre-booked with Show Secretary and pre-paid by May 19.**

TRAILER HOOK-UP: Due to very limited space, contact Show Secretary re. availability and cost. **Must be pre-booked and pre-paid by May 19.**

JUNIOR HANDLING: Conformation. On Saturday in the first available ring. Dogs competing in Junior Handling must be entered in one of the official classes or on Exhibition Only. Registration 10:00 to 11:00 a.m. with the Show Secretary.

Entry fee is \$2.00.

OBEDIENCE TRIALS: Pre-Novice; Novice A, B, & C; Novice Intermediate; Open A & B; Utility. A bitch in season may not compete in Obedience Trials. Entry fees will be refunded if a Veterinarian's Certificate to this effect is received by the Trial Secretary before the Trial commencement.

CONFORMATION AND OBEDIENCE CLASSES: For definition, see reverse side of entry form.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. However, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian funds" or "at par." They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation are appreciated. Thank you.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Dog Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than FIVE points at a single show.
