

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The building will be open at 8 a.m. with judging commencing at 9 a.m. unless entries warrant an earlier or later starting time. **Friday set-up is from 6-8 p.m.**
2. Only dogs entered in these events will be allowed in the building.
3. Dogs will not be allowed in the building overnight.
4. Prong or Spike collars will not be permitted at this venue.
5. ***Judging will proceed without any dog that is not present when called by the Ring Steward. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers should judging times conflict.***
6. All Group judging will begin on completion of Breed judging within each group. Best In Show, Best Puppy In Show, and Reserve Best In Show will follow all Group judging. Reserve Best In Show will immediately follow Best In Show.
7. The Superintendent will be in full charge of the events.
8. The S.S.K.C. reserves the right to restrict the size and location of crates and exercise pens.
9. Dogs between 3 months and 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, provided that the owner has also entered a dog in one of the regular Official Classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.
10. The S.S.K.C. will use all due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of, an accident or any misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
11. The S.S.K.C. greatly appreciates your co-operation in keeping the show building and grounds clean. Please clean up after your dogs.
12. Canteen facilities will be available.
13. Section 19.7 Dog Show Rules: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events. A copy of these Rules is available from the Canadian Kennel Club.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted. However, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques “payable in Canadian funds” or “at par”. They will not be cleared by the banks. - Post-dated cheques will not be accepted, and all “NSF” cheques will be subject to a charge of \$25.00. All fees must be paid before the show.
- The S.S.K.C. reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC rules.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how the error was made or who made it.
- Any overpayment of fees will be considered a contribution to our trophy fund.
- To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trial Secretary after the closing time and date.

A dog awarded Winners which also places Best In Show at an All Breed Conformation Show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the Breed and Group level. A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.
